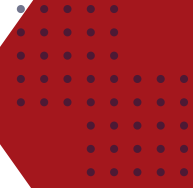

Code of Bus - Behaviour

Code of Behaviour on the School Bus

- Students are to remain in their own seat. Bus Drivers and / or principal will allocate seats.
- Students must be properly seated and wearing seatbelt correctly at all times and avoid turning to face the back of the bus or stand up whilst the bus is in motion.
- All rubbish is to be removed from the bus by the students creating it.
- All students need to be ready and waiting at their bus stop before the nominated pick up time for that stop.
- Students are reminded that the school's Behaviour Code continues to operate on the bus. Travelling on a school bus is a privilege. Inappropriate behaviour may mean using the school bus is denied.
- Travel on a different bus to a student's normal bus will not be permitted unless the school is formally notified by a phone call or in person to the Front Office and then, if approved by the principal and only if a spare seat is available.
- Students are reminded to respect and respond to the authority of the bus driver and to follow all reasonable requests made by the bus driver.
- A teacher is on duty at the end of the day and students move to their buses once released from class. If the bus is not ready to be boarded then students need to wait under the bus shelter until it is ready.
- Students may enter a bus only when the driver is aboard.
- All equipment, personal property and the students are to remain in the bus until directed by the driver.
- All students' equipment and personal property are the responsibility of the student.
